# NOW HIRING HOUSING INSPECTORS

**JOB DESCRIPTION:** The NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development is recruiting qualified individuals for the position of Housing Inspector in the Division of Code Enforcement. Candidates will be required to perform technical work in the inspection of multiple dwellings and other structures to ensure enforcement of the Multiple Dwellings Law, Housing Maintenance Code and other related laws, rules and regulations that govern occupancy, safety and sanitary conditions of such dwellings and structures. Additionally, perform work related to lead based paint assessments and the use of XRF equipment and other related tools.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:** Candidates must have five years of full-time experience in one of the following trades: Journeyman mason, carpenter, plumber, plasterer or ironworker; or have been in charge of the maintenance and repair of multiple dwellings for a real estate management; or performed field inspections requiring the gathering and reporting of data concerning the physical aspects of housing or of building construction or renovation; or three years of experience, as described above plus two years of education in an accredited college or technical school in subjects related to the above; or a baccalaureate degree in engineering, architecture, engineering technology, architectural technology, or construction technology; or any baccalaureate degree plus one year full-time experience in any of the above mentioned trades.
